THE LAST TIME OUT: The hot-hitting Curve were silenced in the finale of a four-game series against the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 6-0, on Sunday. Richmond left-hander Conner Menez fanned eight Curve hitter over six scoreless frames and took a perfect game into the fifth before Jerrick Suiter connected on the first Altoona hit of the day. Richmond hit three homers off Curve starter Scooter Hightower, including a three-run homer by Eastern League Player of the Week Jacob Heyward during a four-run third. Chris Shaw and Jalen Miller hit back-to-back homers for the Squirrels to extend the lead in the fifth. Tate Scioneaux made his 100th appearance as a Curve pitcher and tossed two hitless frames with three strikeouts and one walk.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve start a six-game, week-long homestand beginning with three games against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The series is the first of four total series against Bowie in 2019, totalling 14 head-to-head contests.

THE CURVE: Altoona has seven of their last 11 by outscoring their opponents 63-44. Entering 2019, the Curve own the Eastern League's longest active streak for reaching the postseason while their four straight playoff appearances are tied for a franchise record (2003-06). Over that four-year period, the Curve have the best record (302-258) among Western Division teams while the only teams in the league with better records are Trenton (329-235) and Panding (305-254) Reading (305-254).

THE BAYSOX: Bowie owns the worst record in professional baseball. Being the only team with a winning percentage below .300, there are five other teams in the minors with nine wins and while the Marlins are 9-24 with a MLB-low .273 winning percentage. Two of the Baysox's wins are against league-leading Harrisburg. In their most recent series, Bowie won the first game against Erie, 4-0, before losing the next three games by a combined score of 17-1 on eight total hits. Bowie has been shut out a league-high seven times this season, including two in their last three games. As a team, Bowie is batting a league-low .203 and their 90 runs are 11th among the 12 Eastern League squads. From a pitching perspective, the Baysox team ERA is 4.33, the highest in the league.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander James Marvel makes the his seventh start of the season and his second career outing against Bowie. In Marvel's last start, he extended took a 20.2 scoreless streak that spanned four starts into the seventh inning against Erie before three SeaWolves runs passed in the inning and he was handed his second loss of the year. So far in 2019, Marvel has been one of the league's best pitchers by sporting a 1.98 ERA, 0.88 WHIP and .200 batting average against over 36.1 innings. Marvel was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for April 15-21 after he threw a complete-game shutout over seven innings in Richmond on April 20. Marvel faced Bowie in his final regular-seasons start of 2018 and allowed four runs over six innings of a no-decision on August 31 before the Curve rallied to win in extras. A native of the Bay Area, Marvel was drafted by the Pirates in the 36th round in 2015 after injury limited the righty to just 13 outings in college from 2013-14 at Duke University. FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Hunter Harvey gets the ball for the Baysox to start the series. In his last start, Harvey was tagged for six runs over 2.2 innings against Richmond. His longest start of the year was on April 25 against Akron in which he threw five one-hit, scoreless innings which was also his lone shutout appearance. Harvey made nine starts for the Baysox in 2018, going 1-2 with a 5.57 ERA before he was shut down for the season in early June with shoulder and elbow ailments. Harvey was a former first round draft pick by the Orioles, 22nd overall in 2013, out of his North Carolina high school and pitched in the Futures Game in 2014 at Target Field in Minneapolis.

BRAKE MEN: Curve relievers have teamed up for 12.2 consecutive scoreless innings over the last four games. In the past seven games, the unit has surrendered just two runs over 24.1 innings for a 0.74 ERA. The bullpen's ERA has dropped to 2.80 from from 3.52 since April 29. In those seven games, there have been eight multi-inning, shutout appearances from bullpen arms. **Tate Scioneaux** leads the staff with three outings over that stretch and has allowed one run in 3.2 innings, including three straight scoreless innings pitched in his last two outings. **Jake Brentz**, promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Monday, threw 4.1 scoreless innings over the last week.

MAKING THE PLAYS: Altoona pitchers have recorded the fewest strikeouts (203) in Minor League Baseball and the fifth-fewest walks (72) in the game, which ranks as the fewest among Eastern League teams. With a high rate of balls put into play, the Curve defense has put away outs consistently and are tied with the Triple-A lowa Cubs (Cubs) for the best team fielding percentage in the minors at .987.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Curve offense has found it's rhythm and aided seven wins in the last 11 games. Altoona hitters have produced 63 runs on 101 hits, including 35 extra-base knocks, and a 33-for-104 (.317) mark with men in scoring position during the recent run. Prior to the 63-run outburst, the Curve were limited to 14 runs over their previous eight games and were batting .207 (49/237) as a team, .106 (5/47) with runners in scoring position and had 10 extra-base hits over that period.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** continues to rake in his first season at Double-A. He currently leads the Eastern League with 26 RBIs and stands second in the league with seven homers while the rest of the Curve have combined for eight long balls. Owen's seven home runs and 20 RBIs in April were each the highest April totals by a Curve player since Brad Eldred hit 10 homers and 22 RBIs to open the 2005 season. Coming off Eastern League Player of the Week for April 22-28, Owen is batting .319 (15/47) over his last 12 games with six two-hit performances, four homers, 14 RBIs, four doubles and one triple. His 38 homers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the most by any Pirates minor leaguer over that period.

BLIGH GUY: Outfielder Bligh Madris has reached base in 12 of 13 while hitting safely in eight of his last 13 games with five multi-hit performances. Madris is 15-for-48 (.313) with three doubles, five RBIs and collected his first seven walks of the season. The Las Vegas native is tied for sixth in the league with 31 hits.

OLIVA ON EARLY: Jared Oliva is excelling during the first inning as the Curve leadoff hitter. Over 17 games from the leadoff spot, the he is 6-for-14 with two walks, one hit-by-pitch and one lead-off home run during those game-opening at bats. The Pirates seventh-round selection in 2017 was the primary lead-off man for A-Adv. Bradenton and hit .345 (30/87) with 15 walks in the first inning last season. Oliva is the No. 12 Pirates prospect according to MLB.com.

QUITE THE CATCH: Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** are providing a solid boost to the lineup. In the most recent series against Richmond, Delay went 6-for-8 with one homer, one triple, one double and four RBIs in two games as the Curve backstop. Meanwhile, Pabst went 3-for-8 in the other two games of the series.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) while **Stephen Alemais** (No. 26) **Gage Hinsz** (No. 28) remain on the injured list. All three of those players are also featured on MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects list: Oliva (No. 12), Alemais (No. 26) and Hinsz (30). Oliva was also ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system.
