THE LAST TIME OUT: Bowie starter Hunter Harvey pitched his longest outing since July 5, 2014 and held the Curve scoreless over six two-hit innings. Meanwhile, the Bowie bats broke loose with six runs off Curve starter James Marvel. The Baysox eventually built a 7-0 lead before Altoona rallied for five in the eighth to tighten the score to 7-5 with two-run singles from Bligh Madris and Jerrick Suiter. However, the Baysox extended their lead with three in the top of the ninth with the second home run of the game from Ademar Rifaela, a two-run blast, before a run scoring double later in the frame.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve continue their homestand with the second of three games against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The series is the first of four total series against Bowie in 2019, totalling 14 head-to-head contests.

THE CURVE: Altoona has won seven of their last 12 by outscoring their opponents 68-54, but have lost their last two by a 16-5 margin. Entering 2019, the Curve own the Eastern League's longest active streak for reaching the post-season while their four straight playoff appearances are tied for a franchise record (2003-06). Over that four-year period, the Curve have the best record (302-258) among Western Division teams while the only teams in the league with better records are Trenton (329-235) and Reading (305-254).

THE BAYSOX: Bowie owns the worst record in professional baseball. The Baysox are the lone team in the minors with a winning percentage below .300 while Single-A Columbia (Mets) are 9-21, right at .300. Bowie has been shut out a league-high seven times this season, including two in their previous three games before last night's 10-run outburst. As a team, Bowie is batting a league-low .210 and their 100 runs are 10th among the 12 Eastern League squads. From a pitching perspective, the Baysox team ERA is 4.35, the highest in the league. Since the 2017 season, the Baysox are 23-10 against the Curve.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-handed pitcher **Pedro Vasquez** will make his seventh outing of the season and his sixth start of the campaign. In his last start, Vasquez picked up his second win of the year after he held Richmond to one run through five innings as the Curve rolled to a 9-2 victory on Thursday at The Diamond. He also matched a season high with five strikeouts in the winning effort. Vasquez will make his second career start against Bowie on Tuesday. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by the Mariners as an international free agent in 2015 and was traded to the Pirates organization in September 2016...*For more on Vasquez, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Southpaw Zac Lowther will take the mound for his sixth start of the year. He last appeared for the Baysox on Thursday in Erie and out-dueled SeaWolves starter Gregory Soto with five one-hit, scoreless frames in which he fanned six for his second win of the year. That start began the lone shutout victory for the Baysox to date this season. Lowther was the 74th overall selection in the 2017 draft out of Xavier University and is in his first Double-A season. He was a New York-Penn League All-Star in his 2017 debut season with Aberdeen and has racked up 246 strikeouts in 201.2 innings as a pro.

BRAKE MEN: Curve relievers teamed up for 14 straight scoreless innings over five games before Bowie broke through for one run in the seventh on Monday. In the past eight games, the unit has surrendered just six runs over 28.2 innings for a 1.91 ERA. The bullpen's ERA has dropped to 3.04 from from 3.52 since April 29. In those eight games, Altoona relievers have turned in scoreless multi-inning appearances eight times. **Tate Scioneaux** leads the staff with three outings over that stretch and has allowed one run in 3.2 innings, including three straight scoreless innings pitched over his last two games. **Beau Sulser** pitched 16 innings without a run allowed to start his Double-A career before Ademar Rifaela went deep to start the seventh on Monday.

MAKING THE PLAYS: Altoona pitchers have recorded the fewest strikeouts (209) in Minor League Baseball and the fourth-fewest walks (75) in the game. With a high rate of balls put into play, the Curve defense has put away outs consistently as their .987 fielding percentage ranks first in Double-A and second in all of the minors with the Triple-A Iowa Cubs (Cubs) leading the way at .988.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Curve offense has found it's rhythm and aided seven wins in the last 12 games. Altoona hitters have produced 68 runs on 108 hits, including 35 extra-base knocks, and a 36-for-113 (.319) mark with men in scoring position during the recent run. Prior to the 68-run outburst, the Curve were limited to 14 runs over their previous eight games and were batting .207 (49/237) as a team, .106 (5/47) with runners in scoring position and had 10 extra-base hits over that period.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** continues to rake in his first season at Double-A. He currently leads the Eastern League with 26 RBIs and stands second in the league with seven homers while the rest of the Curve have combined for eight long balls. Through 30 games, the Indiana native is on pace for 33 homers and 121 RBIs, which is on pace to break Adam Hyzdu's single-season records of 31 homers and 106 RBIs. Coming off Eastern League Player of the Week for April 22-28, Owen is batting .300 (15/50) over his last 13 games with six two-hit performances, four homers, 14 RBIs, four doubles and one triple, however, he is 0-for-his-last-12 in his last four games. His 38 homers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the most by any Pirates minor leaguer over that period.

BLIGH GUY: Outfielder **Bligh Madris** broke an 0-for-13 slide with a two-run single in the eighth on Monday and has reached base in 13-of-14 while hitting safely in nine of his last 14 games. Madris is 16-for-52 (.308) with three doubles, seven RBIs and collected his first seven walks of the season over his last 14 games. The Las Vegas native is tied for fifth in the league with 32 hits.

OLIVA ON EARLY: **Jared Oliva** is excelling during the first inning as the Curve leadoff hitter. Over 18 games from the leadoff spot, he is 7-for-15 with two walks, one hit-by-pitch and one lead-off home run during game-opening at bats. The Pirates seventh-round selection in 2017 was the primary leadoff man for A-Adv. Bradenton in 2018 and hit .345 (30/87) with 15 walks in the first inning last season. Oliva is the No. 12 Pirates prospect according to MLB.com.

QUITE THE CATCH: Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** are providing a solid boost to the lineup. Over the last five games, the catching combo are a combined 10-for-20 at the plate with three multi-hit games. Delay has caught three of the last five, going 7-for-12 with four RBIs and three extra-base hits while Pabst is 3-for-8 over his last two games behind the plate.

SUIT UP: First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has compiled a modest six-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the club. Over his last six games, Suiter is 8-for-23 (.348) with two doubles and six RBIs. Suiter lead the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) while **Stephen Alemais** (No. 26) **Gage Hinsz** (No. 28) remain on the injured list. All three of those players are also featured on MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects list: Oliva (No. 12), Alemais (No. 26) and Hinsz (30). Oliva was also ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system.
