**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve were clobbered, 12-2, in their largest loss of the season and dropped the rubber match of their three-game series with the Bowie Baysox. It was the first series victory of the season for the Baysox. Curve starter Sean Brady made his debut in the Pirates organization with Altoona and posted five innings as Bowie scored four time. He departed with the Curve trailing 4-2 before the 'pen surrendered eight runs.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve continue their homestand with the first of three against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The current series is the second of three visits to PNG Field for Erie and the third of six series overall, composed of 20 head-to-head matchups. The SeaWolves have claimed two-of-three in each of the first two meetings this year.

**THE CURVE:** Altoona has won eight of their last 14 but have lost three of their last four on the heels of a three-game winning streak. Over the last four games, the Curve have been outscored 30-10 and are hitting .198 (26/131) with just two extra-base hits. From a pitching perspective, Altoona pitchers hold a 7.46 ERA (29 ER/35 IP) over the last four games while opponents are hitting .299 (43/144) with nine home runs. Entering 2019, the Curve own the Eastern League's longest active streak for reaching the postseason while their four straight playoff appearances are tied for a franchise record (2003-06). Over that four-year period, the Curve have the best record (302-258) among Western Division teams while the only teams in the league with better records are Trenton (329-235) and Reading (305-254).

**THE SEAWOLVES:** Erie has won their last three series and eight of 11 games since April 29 after they were swept over three games in Trenton from April 27-28. Through six games from May 2-8, Erie's pitching staff pitched 44.0 innings without allowing an earned run and did not allow a run at all from the fourth inning on May 4 until the first frame on May 8, a stretch of 23.1 innings. The SeaWolves' pitching staff ranks third overall in team ERA but leads the circuit with six shutout victories. The team's starting rotation paces the E.L. with a 2.54 team ERA and .194 batting average against. Offensively, the SeaWolves rank first among E.L. squads with a .259 average, third with 139 runs scored and tied for fifth with 21 homers.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander **Cam Vieaux** makes his seventh start of the season and second against Erie. Vieaux is coming off his first win of the year when the Curve offense nearly doubled his season total in run support in a 9-2 win on Saturday in Richmond. In his last start against Erie, the Novi, Mich. native was on the losing end of Casey Mize's no-hitter in Altoona on April 29 despite seven innings of one-run ball. Vieaux made 15 starts with the Curve in 2018 and finished tied for the team lead with nine winning decisions to be named Altoona Curve Pitcher of the Year. At PNG Field in 2018, Vieaux went 7-1 in nine starts with a 2.47 ERA compared to a 5.15 ERA and a 2-4 record over seven starts on the road. The Pirates drafted Vieaux in the sixth round in 2016 out of Michigan State...*For more on Vieaux, see page two.*

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Casey Mize makes his third start for the SeaWolves and second against the Curve after he tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in his Double-A debut on April 29 at PNG Field. In his second start and winning decision for Erie, Mize retired the first eight batters on May 4 vs. Bowie prior to a weak, two-out hit in the third and allowed one unearned run during the fourth. Through six starts in 2019 between Double-A Erie and A-Adv. Lakeland, the first overall pick in the 2018 draft owns the lowest batting average against (.071) among pitchers with at least 20 innings pitched and is 4-0 with a 0.23 ERA. Mize is Detroit's top overall prospect, according to both *Baseball America* and MLB.com.

**NOT SO HOME SWEET HOME:** The Curve have been outscored 72-49 at home and are 5-10 through their first 15 games at PNG Field. The team is batting .230 at home vs. .253 on the road and are averaging 1.1 runs per game fewer at home. The 5-10 start through the first 15 home games is a franchise low, which has been done a total of four times over the club's 21-year history. The last occurrence in 2009 resulted in a franchise-low 31 home wins.

**MAKING THE PLAYS:** Altoona pitchers have recorded the fewest strikeouts (222) in Minor League Baseball and the sixth-fewest walks (83) in the game. With a high rate of balls put into play, the Curve defense has put away outs consistently as their .987 fielding percentage ranks first in Double-A and second in all of the minors with the Triple-A Iowa Cubs (Cubs) leading the way at .989.

**OLIVA ON EARLY:** **Jared Oliva** is excelling during the first inning as the Curve leadoff hitter. Over 20 games from the leadoff spot, he is 7-for-16 (.438) with three walks, one hit-by-pitch and one lead-off home run during game-opening at bats. The Pirates seventh-round selection in 2017 was the primary leadoff man for A-Adv. Bradenton in 2018 and hit .345 (30/87) with 15 walks in the first inning last season. Oliva is the No. 12 Pirates prospect according to MLB.com.

**QUITE THE CATCH:** Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** are providing a solid boost to the lineup. Over the last seven games, the catching combo are a combined 12-for-27 (.444) at the plate with four multi-hit games. Delay has caught four of the last seven, going 9-for-15 with five RBIs and four extra-base hits while Pabst is 3-for-12 over his last three games behind the plate.

**ACTION JACKSON:** Outfielder **Bralin Jackson** has feasted on E.L. pitchers over the last two weeks, batting .410 (16/39) over his last 11 games with four doubles, five RBIs and six multi-hit games. Jackson was batting .191 over his first 16 games of the year before boosting his average to .291 after the recent surge. A native of Independence, Mo., Jackson is in his second season with the Curve after batting .214 with three homers, seven doubles and a .557 OPS over 64 games in 2018.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** continues to rake in his first season at Double-A. He currently leads the Eastern League with 26 RBIs and stands second in the league with seven homers while the rest of the Curve have combined for eight long balls. Through 32 games, the Indiana native is on pace for 31 homers and 113 RBIs, which is on pace to approach Adam Hyzdu's single-season franchise records of 31 homers and 106 RBIs. Coming off Eastern League Player of the Week for April 22-28, Owen is batting .296 (16/54) over his last 15 games with six two-hit performances, four homers, 14 RBIs, four doubles and one triple. However, he is 1-for-14 in his last five games. His 38 homers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the most by any Pirates minor leaguer over that period.

**BLIGH GUY:** Outfielder **Bligh Madris** broke a 0-for-13 slide with a two-run single in the eighth on Monday and has reached base in 13-of-14 with hits in nine of those 14 games. Madris is 16-for-52 (.308) with three doubles, seven RBIs and collected his first seven walks of the season over his last 14 games. The Las Vegas native is tied for fifth in the league with 32 hits.

**SUIT UP:** First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** had his six-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday after an 0-for-3 showing but bounced back with another knock on Wednesday. Over his last eight games to start May, Suiter is batting .300 (9/30) with two doubles and six RBIs. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) while **Stephen Alemais** (No. 26) **Gage Hinsz** (No. 28) remain on the injured list. All three of those players are also featured on MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects list: Oliva (No. 12), Alemais (No. 26) and Hinsz (30). Oliva was also ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system.
