**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve were swept in a double-header on Tuesday by 7-0 and 5-1 scores. Binghamton left-hander Anthony Kay tossed a three-hit, complete-game shutout in the first contest. In the second game, Pat Mazeika ended the twin bill with a walk-off grand slam with two outs in the bottom of the seventh. The only run scored by the Curve was a solo homer by right-handed reliever Beau Sulser.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve completes a three-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. The two clubs will play a total of 10 games in 2019 while the current series is the first of two three-game sets at NYSEG Stadium. The Curve went undefeated in Binghamton in 2018 and had lost a game at the ballpark since May 18, 2017 before yesterday's doubleheader sweep. The current series is the first time this season the Curve have faced an Eastern Division team. The Curve have been swept one time in 2019, a three-game set vs. Harrisburg on April 15-17.

THE CURVE: Altoona has lost their last three games and six of their last nine. Entering 2019, the Curve own the Eastern League's longest active streak for reaching the postseason while their four straight playoff appearances are tied for a franchise record (2003-06). Over that four-year period, the Curve have the best record (302-258) among Western Division teams while the only teams in the league with better records are Trenton (329-235) and Reading (305-254).

THE RUMBLE PONIES: Binghamton has won 11 of their last 15 games dating back to April 30 to claim first place in the Eastern Division. The team ranks third in the Eastern League in hitting at .244 and 4.9 runs per game. From the pitching side, Binghamton pitchers rank third in the league with a 3.05 ERA and second in lowest team batting average at .216. The Rumble Ponies have played a league-low 33 games and have had 10 games postponed to date and have made up five in double-headers so far.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher Sean Brady will make his second start for Altoona. In his last start, Brady was tagged with the loss after four runs scored during his five innings of work in his Pirates organization debut. In four career starts against Binghamton, Brady is 0-2 with a 6.10 ERA (14 ER/20.2 IP). He paced the Eastern League with 27 starts last season and pitched seven scoreless innings at PNG Field during Game 4 of the 2018 ELDS to eliminate the Curve from championship contention. He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Cleveland Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school...For more on Brady, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Harol Gonzalez makes his sixth outing of the year and his fifth start. In his last outing, Gonzalez pitched 6.2 no-hit innings before Ryder Ryan finished the last 2.1 innings of a the Rumble Ponies no-hitter on May 8 in Harrisburg. It was the first no-no by the Binghamton franchise since July 23, 2006. The 24-year-old struck out and walked two and was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the May 6-12. Now in his second Double-A season, Gonzalez went 0-9 in nine starts with a 7.79 ERA. He made one start against the Curve on August 21, 2018 and made his way through seven innings with five early runs allowed in a 9-2 Altoona victory.

MAKING THE PLAYS: Altoona pitchers have recorded the fewest strikeouts (248) in Minor League Baseball and the sixth-fewest walks (109) in Double-A. With a high rate of balls put into play, the Curve defense has put away outs consistently as their .987 fielding percentage ranks as the best defensive mark in the minors.

**OLIVA ON EARLY: Jared Oliva** is excelling during the first inning as the Curve leadoff hitter. Over 23 games from the leadoff spot, the he is 9-for-21 (.429) with three walks, one hit-by-pitch and one lead-off home run during gameopening at bats. The Pirates seventh-round selection in 2017 was the primary leadoff man for A-Adv. Bradenton in 2018 and hit .345 (30/87) with 15 walks in the first inning last season. Oliva is the No. 12 Pirates prospect according to MLB.com.

**DELAY DOING DAMAGE:** Catcher **Jason Delay** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games since April 17 and is batting .410 (16/39) with five walks and one hit by pitch over that stretch. He has hit safely in eight of his last 10, hitting .457 (16/35) with five multi-hit games, two homers, four doubles, one triple and 11 RBIs. Delay was drafted in the fourth round by Pittsburgh in the 2017 draft.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** continues to rake in his first season at Double-A. He currently ranks tied for second in the Eastern League with 27 RBIs and third with seven homers. Owen was named Eastern League Player of the Week for April 22-28 and is batting .315 (23/73) over his last 20 games with nine two-hit performances, four homers, 14 RBIs, six doubles and one triple. He has hit safely in five-of-six games, going 8-for-23 (.348) with two doubles. His 38 homers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the most by any Pirates minor leaguer over that period.

**SUIT UP:** First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has racked up 11 RBIs and hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games to start the month of May. Over that period, Suiter is batting \_289 (13/45) with two doubles and four multi-RBI games, including five RBIs over his last five games. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero.

**KING OF THE HILL:** Outfielder **Logan Hill** has reached base in 11 straight games since May 2. Over his last 11 games, Hill is batting .342 (13/38) with one double, one homer, seven RBIs and six walks. Since April 22, Hill has reached base in 16 of 19 games with four doubles, three homers, 12 RBIs

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospects in Jared Oliva (No. 19) while Stephen Alemais (No. 26) Gage Hinsz (No. 28) remain on the injured list. All three of those players are also featured on MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects list: Oliva (No. 12), Alemais (No. 26) and Hinsz (30). Oliva was also ranked by B.A. as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system
