**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve lost the series finale to the Fisher Cats, 7-2, to finish a three-game sweep to start the road trip. Altoona's bats were neutralized by another strong starting effort by New Hampshire as Patrick Murphy pitched six innings with one run allowed to compliment seven strikeouts. The Fisher Cats scored all seven of their runs on three swings: a three-run triple by Kevin Smith in the third, a two-run homer from Alberto Mineo in the fifth and a two-run double by Vinny Capra in the sixth. Both Curve runs scored on hits by Jerrick Suiter, one on a single in the fourth and a double in the ninth. Over the three games in New Hampshire, the Curve was outscored 14-3 while New Hampshire starters combined on a 3-0 record and allowed two runs over 19 innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve take their season-long, 10-game road trip to Maine with the first of four against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, over the Memorial Day weekend. The current series is Altoona's lone visit to Hadlock Field in 2019 and will host the Sea Dogs for three games on June 11-13 at PNG Field.

**MORE OF THE SAME:** The Curve are in the midst of playing 16 of 23 games on the road from May 13-June 5. The Curve are also playing 23 consecutive games with the designated hitter due to American League opposition until June 13. The current series against Portland is the third series against an Eastern Division opponent for Altoona and the second of four straight sets of inter-division play.

**THE CURVE:** Altoona has played .500 baseball for the majority of the season after a matching a franchise-best 5-0 record to begin the season followed by a stumble to 6-8. Altoona's lineup ranks fourth in the Eastern League in hitting at .245, ninth with 26 homers and sixth on the circuit with a .253 mark with runners in scoring position while scoring 4.0 runs per game. Altoona's pitching staff entered play last Thursday with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 2.85 ERA (19 ER/60.0 IP) over the last eight games shaved it down to 4.03.

**THE SEA DOGS:** Portland enters play tied with A-Adv. Jupiter (Marlins) for the worst record in the Minors and are the only two clubs with a winning percentage below .300. The Sea Dogs are coming off the road from a 9-game road trip to Reading and Trenton in which they went 1-8, including one win in five games against the Thunder in their most recent series. The club's -62 run differential is the second-highest disparity in the league behind Richmond's -63. Portland's pitching staff has the highest ERA (4.31) in the league and have issued the most walks. From a hitting perspective, the Sea Dogs lineup ranks eighth in hitting (.232), last in homers (23) and runs (3.2 per game) while batting .214 with runners in scoring position, second-worst on the circuit. The Sea Dogs will be hosting three Red Sox on MLB rehab: infielders Dustin Pedroia and Brock Holt (2011-12 Curve) and left-handed pitcher Brian Johnson.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **James Marvel** makes the his league-leading 10th start of the season and first career start against Portland. In his last start, Marvel snapped a three-game losing streak with his team-high fifth quality start, holding Harrisburg to two runs over six innings, and earned his fourth win. Marvel was the Curve's Opening Day starter and started the year 3-1 with a 1.52 ERA over his first five starts before he went 0-3 with a 9.18 ERA (17 ER/16.2 IP) over his next three outings. A native of the Bay Area, Marvel was drafted by the Pirates in the 36th round in 2015 after injury limited the righty to just 13 outings in college from 2013-14 at Duke University. *For more on Marvel, see page two.*

**FOR PORTLAND:** Right-hander Denyi Reyes gets the ball for Portland in his ninth starting assignment of the season. Reyes has suffered six losses in his previous eight starts with the only two no-decisions coming as a result of his lone quality starts. During his last appearance, the 22-year-old Double-A rookie threw held Reading to one run on three hits over five innings but was on the wrong end of a 5-4 Fightin's win. Reyes is a two-time all-star with short-season Lowell in 2017 and Single-A Greenville in 2018. He was also named the South Atlantic League's Most Outstanding Pitcher with the Drive after he went 10-3 with a 1.89 ERA in 21 outings before moving up to A-Adv. Salem in August. During the 2017 season, Reyes went 9-0 with a 1.45 ERA in 62 innings.

**TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** After carrying a 3.13 ERA (72 ER/207 IP) that ranked fourth in the Eastern League in April, Altoona's pitching staff has carried a 5.16 ERA (103 ER/179.2 IP) over 21 games in May, the highest in the league. The rotation owned a 2.98 ERA entering play on May 3 but has swelled to 4.35, the highest among E.L. starting staffs. Over the last 19 games, Curve starters have a 6.48 ERA (67 ER/93.0 IP) but own a 3.79 (17 ER/40.1 IP) in the last seven games.

**MAKING THE PLAYS:** The Curve defense owns the highest fielding percentage (.986) in Minor League Baseball. They have done so as Altoona pitchers put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (299) in the Minors and the sixth-fewest walks (133) in Double-A.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** is thriving during his first Double-A season. He currently ranks in the top seven of all three Eastern League Triple Crown categories: second with 32 RBIs, third with 10 home runs and seventh with a .307 average. Additionally, he has the third-most hits (47) and second-best extra-base hit (22) and run (30) totals in the league. Owen is batting .338 (33/98) over his last 27 games since April 23 with 12 two-hit performances and 16 extra-base hits, including seven homers and 20 RBIs. Following an 0-for-10 slide over three games from May 4-6, the Indiana State product has hit safely in 11-of-14 at a .347 pace (17/49). Owen's 41 homers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the most by any Pirates minor league over the last three seasons.

**KING OF THE HILL:** After a 16-game on-base streak, **Logan Hill** went 0-for-10 to start the road trip before two late-inning doubles in Thursday. He is batting .333 (31/93) since April 24 and reached base in 21 of 25 games with three homers, seven doubles, 19 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .292. Hill is ranked second in the E.L. with 13 doubles and third with 28 runs scored. He also stands eighth with 27 RBIs and 45 hits are fifth-most.

**SUIT UP:** First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has hit home all three runs for the Curve on the current road trip. In the month of May, the TCU products has racked up 16 RBIs and hit safely in 16 of 21 games in May. Suiter launched his first homer of the season on Wednesday night during a two-hit night and added two more knocks on Thursday, going 4-for-11 to kick off the road trip. Overall in May, Suiter is batting .292 (21/72) with four doubles and five multi-RBI games. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero while helping the club capture the second league championship in franchise history.

**TRENDING UP:** Arden Pabst owns the longest hitting streak on the team at three games while **Jared Oliva's** five-game on-base streak is now the longest active streak on the club. Pabst has an extra-base hit in each of his last three games, going 4-for-11 with a triple and two doubles while driving in 4 RBIs. Pabst caught one of three games in Portland in 2018, going 2-for-5 with four RBIs and a homer over the Maine Monster. Oliva went 2-for-4 on Thursday for his first multi-hit game since May 10 and has been on base in 16 of his last 19 games since April 30.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) while **Stephen Alemais** (No. 26) and **Gage Hinsz** (No. 28) remain on the injured list. All three of those players are also featured on MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects list: Oliva (No. 12), Alemais (No. 26) and Hinsz (30). Oliva was also ranked by B.A. as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system.
