**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve were defeated, 7-3, by Hartford after three more homers by the Yard Goats. A three-run blast by Bret Boswell got Hartford on the board after a two-out error at first base extended the inning. All of those runs were unearned against **Pedro Vasquez**, who struck out seven over his six-inning start for the Curve. **Chris Sharpe** hit his first Double-A homer in the seventh to tie the game, 3-3, but Brian Serven hit **Austin Coley's** first pitch for a go-ahead home run to start a three-run frame for the Yard Goats. After the first two games of the series, Hartford has homered six times and the Curve have cleared the fence three times.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve look to avoid a three-game sweep in the finale of their three-game series with the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the only visit to Dunkin' Donuts Park for Altoona in 2019 while Hartford will make the trek to PNC Field for three games on August 19-21. Altoona has not been swept since a three-game set in New Hampshire on May 21-23 and have been swept twice this season. The Curve are playing the eighth of 16 straight National League-style games through the end of June before using a designated hitter against American League-affiliated squads for all but four games in July.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve are 13-6 in June, second-best in the league behind Bowie's 15-4 month, and have won 5 of 6 series. Altoona has homered in each of the last seven games away from PNC Field and have gone deep 15 times this month after hitting a league-low 30 homers in April and May. The Curve hold a 7-14 record against the Eastern Division and have lost all but one road series in Eastern Division ballparks. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

**THE YARD GOATS:** Hartford was the best team in the E.L. during May, going 19-8 and won 12 of 16 before dropping 6 of their last 9. Hartford's pitching staff leads the league at a 2.86 ERA and have issued the fewest walks on the circuit with the second-most strikeouts. Additionally, the Hartford bullpen ranks first in the league with a 2.42 ERA. From a hitting perspective, the 'Goats leave the yard at the highest rate in the league with 63 homers despite the second-lowest team batting average of .227. Yard Goats games have been low-scoring affairs, averaging 3.6 runs scored (second-lowest offensively) to 3.3 runs allowed (lowest defensively). Hartford is 11-21 against Western Division clubs and are coming off a three-game sweep to Bowie to start their homestand.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-handed pitcher **Sean Brady** will make his ninth start for the Curve and 14th outing overall in 2019. Brady last pitched on June 17 and was handed a third straight loss with four runs, two earned, over six innings against Harrisburg. The Florida native has eaten up at least six innings in seven of his eight starts with the Curve, including five quality starts. Brady is set to face Hartford for the first time in his career in his 39th Eastern League start. He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school...*For more on Brady, see page two.*

**FOR HARTFORD:** Left-hander Jack Wynkoop takes the hill for the 15th time and first against the Curve. The 25-year-old pitched a season-high eight innings but took the loss during his latest start in the homestand opener against Bowie on Tuesday and limited the Baysox to two runs despite eight hits. The Virginia Beach native has pitched for the Yard Goats since the start of the 2017 season and is 13-25 with a 4.60 ERA in 54 starts and leads the league with 86 innings pitched, ranks eighth in the league with a 1.05 WHIP and has allowed the second-most homers (12) on the circuit. He'll make his third career start against the Curve and first since 2017 when he went 0-2 with a 8.74 ERA (11 ER/11.1 IP). Wynkoop was drafted by the Rockies during the sixth round of the 2015 draft out of South Carolina.

**BRAKE MEN:** Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league. Over the last 32 games, the pitching staff has lowered it to 3.72 thanks to a 3.13 ERA (96 ER/275.2 IP), the third-lowest mark in the league over that period. In June, Altoona pitchers have the second-lowest ERA (2.78) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00). Additionally, the bullpen owns a 2.52 ERA (14 ER/50 IP) over the last 16 games that included an eight-game stretch of 22 consecutive scoreless innings from June 12-June 21.

**GLOVE TRAIN:** The Curve defense has the highest fielding percentage (.984) in Minor League Baseball and have turned the third-most double plays (70) among Double-A clubs. Altoona defenders have put away outs with pitchers putting a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (488) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (195) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** **Jared Oliva** has been on base in 16 of his last 17 games while batting .274 (17/62) with four multi-hit games, five doubles, two homers, seven steals, 12 runs and eight walks since June 3. The Pirates' seventh-round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent upswing to .218. Oliva's 15 steals for the Curve are third-most in the E.L. and ranks tied for second in the Pirates system. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

**BLIGH GUY:** **Bligh Madris** is heating up in June and has collected 19 hits over his last 18 games since June 2, batting .317 (19/60) with three homers, five doubles, one triple, nine walks and 11 RBIs during six multi-hit games. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

**TOLMAN AT THE TOP:** In 11 games as the Curve leadoff hitter, **Mitchell Tolman** is batting .326 (14/43) with two home runs, three walks, two hit-by-pitch and nine runs scored. He has taken over the top spot in the lineup in each of the last three games and is 6-for-11 (.545). The former Oregon Duck has hit safely in 14 of 17 at a .333 (22/66) pace.

**ROBBIE'S RETURN:** **Robbie Glendinning**, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton last Thursday and has gone 5-for-21 with a homer, one double, five RBIs and six walks in six games. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games at the start of the campaign before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The Aussie tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .328 average between the two levels leads all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, Curve shortstops are batting a combined .205 (44/215).

**LOOKIN' SHARPE:** The newest member of the 2017 Pirates draft class to be promoted to Altoona, **Chris Sharpe**, has made an immediate impact. He doubled and singled in his first two Double-A at bats on Friday and hit a game-tying, two-run homer on Saturday. He was a Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton before he was called up and ranked third in the league with a .836 OPS at the time of his promotion. His .294 average between Double-A Altoona and A-Adv. Bradenton ranks second among Pirates minor leaguers.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (25) and second-most RBIs (41) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League while batting a combined .245. Pabst has 13 RBIs in his last 17 games with eight extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .283 (17/60) since May 16. Delay is hitting .267 (23/86) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 23 games since May 3.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.
