THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve dropped a 7-2 decision on Tuesday to even up the series. The RubberDucks cut the night short to 2.1 innings for **Domingo Robles** with a five-run third and sent 10 men to the plate before scoring single runs in the fourth and eighth. The Curve scored first when **Mitchell Tolman** doubled and scored on a **Jared Oliva** single three batters into the game. **Jason Delay** and **Alfredo Reyes** combined on doubles in the fifth for the second run of the night. Delay doubled twice while Reyes had two knocks and Oliva had three singles.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve play the rubber match of their three-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The Curve are 5-4 in series-deciding games this year, including wins in each of their last three. Today is the final game of the season at Canal Park for Altoona and a win would surpass the 2004 Curve's 8-2 record in Akron for the best mark in team history. With five head-to-head games remaining between the two teams, the Curve can clinch the season series with their next win over the RubberDucks. Akron visits Altoona in the team's final home series of 2019 on August 26-29.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 20-10 since June 1, trailing only Bowie (22-7) for the best record in the Eastern League over that time. During that hot stretch, the Curve have won 7 of 8 series. Altoona has the best intra-division record (32-22) among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE RUBBERDUCKS: Akron went 34-35 in the first half to finish third in the Western Division and have hovered near .500 most of the season. The 'Ducks were a season-low six games under .500 on May 10 and went a league-best 20-11 run from May 11-June 13 to reach a season-best three games over .500 (34-31). However, Akron has lost 13 of 20. After a brief, three-game stay, Akron will play the last four games before the All-Star Break at Binghamton and will resume play against Bowie at Canal Park on July 11. The 'Ducks lead the E.L. with 74 home runs and runs scored (357) while the pitching staff ranks fifth in the league with a 3.44 ERA.

FOR ALTOONA: Eastern League All-Star right-hander **Pedro Vasquez** will make his 15th outing and 17th overall between Double-A and Triple-A. The 23-year-old went 3-0 in June while leading the Eastern League with 0.87 ERA and 0.74 WHIP last month. He last worked on Friday against Binghamton and had a no-decision after six three-run innings on seven strikeouts. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was traded to the Pirates organization in September 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero...*For more on Vasquez, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Sam Hentges will be the first pitcher in the Eastern League to make his 17th start and faces Altoona for the first time since he took the hill at Canal Park on Opening Day. The Curve hit Hentges for five runs, four earned, over 4.1 innings to start the season. In his most recent start, the 22-year-old allowed two runs in 4.2 innings during a no-decision at Bowie. Despite his 1-8 record, Hentges has five quality starts that includes a season-high seven scoreless on May 15 against Bowie. Hentges was drafted by the Indians in the fourth round in 2014 out of Mounds View (Minn.) High School and is ranked by MLB.com as the Tribe's No. 10 prospect.

CHANGING THE NARRATIVE: Monday's win clinched a share of the season series against Akron. The Curve have won or split the series with Akron in each **Michael Ryan**'s three seasons as Curve manager with a 31-24 record. In 21 seasons, the Curve will finish with a .500 or better record against Akron for the seventh time and seek the fifth win in the season series and the first time in consecutive seasons. With a 5-1 record at Canal Park in 2019, the Curve have already claimed a winning record in Akron for just the fourth time in franchise. Akron has been the toughest Western Division city for the Curve to win with a .409 winning percentage in 208 games overall.

TOUGH YEAR TO HIT: The league-wide average stands at .237 with teams are scoring 3.96 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95). The last time the E.L. saw offenses hit below .240 and score fewer than 4.0 runs per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The Curve are above the league average with 4.0 runs per game and rank second in hitting at .245. The lowest batting average in team history stands at .252 during the 2013 season.

BRAKE MEN: Curve pitchers entered play on May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league. The staff has lowered that mark to 3.67 over the last 43 games by holding 3.18 ERA (131 ER/370.2 IP), the third-best mark in the league over that period. In June, Altoona pitchers had the lowest ERA (2.78) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00). The bullpen owns a 2.30 ERA (22 ER/86.0 IP) over the last 27 games.

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: **Robbie Glendinning** keeps hitting to lead the Pirates organization with a .333 average between Altoona and A-Adv. Bradenton while pacing the system with 81 total hits. He also ranks among the top performers in the Pirates system with 11 homers (6th), 21 doubles (T-2nd) and 44 RBIs (T-5th), all career-highs. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star, the Western Australian native is hitting .328 (20/61) with seven extra-base hits, 14 RBIs and seven walks in his last 17 games since he rejoined the Curve on June 13. Glendinning was on the Curve's Opening Day roster and hit .300 (6/20) over nine games before he was sent to down on April 18. He responded with a FSL-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games with the Marauders.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: **Jared Oliva** has reached base in 25 of his last 27 games since June 3 while batting .329 (32/97) with nine multi-hit games, nine doubles, three homers, 13 RBIs, 10 steals, 16 runs and 12 walks. He was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent upswing to .249. Over his last 17 games since June 14, he is hitting .383 (23/60) with eight doubles, one homer, nine steals and eight walks. Oliva's 18 steals are tied for second in the E.L. and second in the Pirates system. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system.

TOLMAN AT THE TOP: Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has reached base in 12 of 13 games while hitting at a .333 (16/48) pace with 13 runs scored. Tolman has hit leadoff in 21 games this season and owns a .300 (24/80) ledger from the top of the lineup. Since June 3, he has reached base in 24 of 27 and is batting .311 (32/103) with 18 runs, seven steals and seven extra-base hits.

BLIGH GUY: **Bligh Madris** has batted .271 (26/96) and been on base in 23 of 28 games since June 2 with three homers, six doubles, one triple, 12 walks and 15 RBIs during eight multi-hit performances. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: **Chris Sharpe** has come through with some big hits and has eight RBIs over his last four games. On Saturday, Sharpe hit a walk-off single in extra innings against Binghamton before he hit a go-ahead grand slam on Sunday in Altoona. In Monday's game, Sharpe gave the Curve a 2-1 lead in the third on a single to center before a game-tying, two-run double during a three-run eighth. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star, Sharpe was promoted to Double-A on June 21 and ranks fifth in the Pirates system with .274 overall batting average, third with a .365 on-base percentage and third with 15 stolen bases.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by B.A. as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).

HANG A STAR ON THAT ONE: The Curve are sending three players to the Eastern League All-Star Game with right-handed pitchers **Pedro Vasquez** and **Beau Sulser** joining catcher **Jason Delay**. Sulser was selected to join the Western Division roster after **James Marvel** was promoted to Triple-A on Monday. The 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game will be in Richmond on Wednesday, July 10.
