**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve lost a late lead in Erie when Jose Azocar hit a game-winning, two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth that boosted the SeaWolves to a 6-5 lead. Down 4-2 after five innings, Altoona put up three in the sixth with RBI singles from **Bligh Madris** and **Robbie Glendinning** to take a 5-4, which held until Azocar's homer. **Jared Oliva** hit a two-run homer in the third inning while the Curve and SeaWolves split the four-game set.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve welcome the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, for the first contest of a three-game series. Meeting for the second series of the season, the two clubs completed one of three games scheduled in Trenton on May 28-30. Storms and heavy rain disrupted the entire series and delayed the first game of the set, which ended in a 6-5 Trenton win. After a postponement on May 29 created a double-header the next day, the two teams were in the third inning with Altoona leading 6-0 when the game was suspended and the second contest was postponed. When the Curve head to Trenton on July 30-August 1, the suspended game will be completed on the first day of the series with a double-header set for August 1.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve have won 9 of 12 and are 26-12 since June 1, the second-best record in the league behind Bowie (29-9) over that period. Altoona has also won 9 of 11 series in that time. Altoona played seven straight games against Erie around the Eastern League All-Star Break and swept three games at PNG Field before the two teams split a four-game series in Erie. The Curve have the best intra-division record (38-24) among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

**THE THUNDER:** Trenton punched their ticket to the playoffs for the fourth straight season as First Half Eastern Division Champions. They finished tied with Reading on June 18 and, due to no head-to-head matchups against the R-Phils in the first half, were awarded the third tie-breaker due to a 20-12 record against teams in their division. The Thunder are on a seven-game road trip after the Eastern League All-Star Break and split a four-game series in Reading, their first visit of the season to FirstEnergy Stadium. Before the break, the Thunder lost seven straight to begin July before winning the finale before three days off. Offensively, Trenton is tied for seventh in the league in runs per game (4.1) and team batting average (.240) but are fourth with runners in scoring position (.255). Trenton pitchers sit seventh with a 3.58 ERA with the fifth-best bullpen at 3.01 despite the second-worst rotation at 4.10.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Pedro Vasquez** will make his 16th outing and 18th overall between Double-A and Triple-A. The 23-year-old went 3-0 in June while leading the Eastern League with 0.87 ERA and 0.74 WHIP last month and has not worked in a game since July 3, when he allowed four runs over six innings at Akron. Vasquez pitched a 1-2-3 third inning in the Eastern League All-Star Game in Richmond to aid a 5-0 victory for the Western Division over the Eastern Division last Wednesday. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was acquired by the Pirates in a trade on September 1, 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero...*For more on Vasquez, see page two.*

**FOR TRENTON:** Right-hander Nick Nelson starts for his 10th outing overall and ninth with Trenton. He last appeared on July 7 in relief and threw three scoreless innings for his third winning decision. In his last starting role on July 2, he struck out 11 batters in Portland and threw a six-inning complete game but shouldered a losing decision in a 1-0 defeat. He started the season with Trenton and landed on the injured list after two starts in April. He was activated in June and was sent to A-Adv. Tampa, where he made a 3.2 inning start against Bradenton, before returning to the Thunder on June 7. Nelson pitched at three levels in 2018, including three regular-season starts and one playoff start for Trenton, and went a combined 8-6 with a 3.55 ERA in 26 total games. He was drafted by the Yankees in the fourth round during the 2016 draft and is ranked by MLB.com as the Yankees' No. 11 overall prospect.

**WILD, WILD WEST:** The Curve have the best overall record in the Western Division at 49-40, leading Harrisburg by a half game. Due to the new split-season playoff format, the Curve are 3.5 games behind Bowie for the last remaining spot in the Western Division playoffs. Harrisburg won the first half with a 42-28 record, 5.5 games better than Altoona's 35-32 first half. The Senators started 21-4 through the month of April but have gone 29-38 since. Meanwhile, Bowie has taken advantage of new life after June 19 to lead the division and are 41-20 since May 6 after a 7-23 start.

**STRANGER THINGS:** Over the last week, the Curve have won two games in which they were struck out 17 and 18 times. However, they drew 10 walks and lost on Sunday.

**YEAR OF THE PITCHER:** The league-wide batting average stands at .238 with teams scoring 3.99 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The Curve are above the league average with 4.06 runs per game and rank third in hitting at .243. The lowest batting average in team history was .252 during the 2013 season.

**BRAKE MEN:** The Curve pitching staff has been dialed in over the last two months and owns the second-best ERA in the league since May 16 (51 games) at 3.13 (154 ER/442.2 IP) and June 3 (36 games) at 2.95 (103 ER/314.0 IP). After a 6.82 ERA over 12 games from May 3-15, the club's ERA ballooned to a league-high 4.22 but has been trimmed down to 3.59 due to the prolonged run of success.

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** **Jared Oliva** set a career-high with five RBIs on Saturday and hit a two-run homer on Sunday. Over his last 24 games since June 14, Oliva leads the Eastern League with a .409 (36/88) batting average, .625 slugging percentage, .495 on-base percentage, 1.120 OPS, 36 hits and 16 steals. He also has the best slashline (.408/.500/.620) in the E.L. since the start of the second half on June 19. Oliva was hitting a season-low .193 through 39 games but has been on base in 32 of his last 35 games since June 3 to boost his average to .273 thanks to a .360 (45/125) pace, also the best in the league over that period. Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and Pirates system with 25 steals. Oliva's .273 average is 14th in the league and tied for third-best among Pirates minor leaguers. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system.

**TOLMAN AT THE TOP:** Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has reached base in 19 of 20 games, including a team-best 16 in a row, while hitting .307 (23/75). Since the start of the second half, Tolman leads the league with 19 runs scored, ranks eighth in hitting and third with 13 walks and a .429 on-base percentage. Since June 3, he reached base in 31 of 34 and is batting .300 (39/130) with 23 runs, eight steals and nine extra-base hits.

**G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE:** Since his promotion from A-Adv. Bradenton, **Robbie Glendinning's** 21 RBIs in 25 games are the second-best total in the Eastern League. The Western Australia native leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a .322 batting average (min. 250 plate appearances) and 88 hits while his career-high 11 homers (6th), 51 RBIs (T-3rd) and 23 doubles (T-2nd) between two levels also rank among the organization's best. Glendinning was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve.

**BLIGH GUY:** **Bligh Madris** leads the club with 24 multi-hit games and has recorded 11 of them in his last 27 games since June 12, batting .309 (30/97). Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by B.A. as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cedertind** (No. 30).

Ryan returns for his third season in Altoona after guiding the Curve to back-to-back Western Division championships. In his first season, the Curve captured the 2017 Eastern League title. He also managed the Western Division All-Stars in the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Classic. Ryan started his coaching career as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.

Hanrahan joins the Curve in 2019 for his third season as a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh minor league system. He started his coaching career with the Bristol Pirates in 2017 and most recently oversaw pitchers for the West Virginia Power last year. Hanrahan was a two-time National League All-Star with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 and 2012 while he served as the team's closer. He was the first Buccs closer to notch 40 saves in a single season and recorded 82 saves, fifth all-time, during four seasons in Pittsburgh. A second-round pick by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2000, he played 14 totals seasons and seven years as a right-handed reliever in the majors.

Nunnally comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 12th season as a coach in professional baseball. During the 2010-11 seasons, he was the hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians under manager Manny Acta. Nunnally spent the last two seasons as the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. He has served as a hitting coach in the Indians, Toronto Blue Jays and Boston Red Sox developmental systems with Eastern League stops in New Hampshire (2012, 14) and Portland (2016). As a player, Nunnally was drafted by Cleveland in the third round in 1992 and played 15 seasons. He also played six major league seasons.

Paniagua joins the Curve for his third season as a coach in the Pirates organization. He started his coaching career in 2017 with the Bristol Pirates and was the hitting coach for the Dominican Summer League affiliate last year. He played for 13 years as an international signee out of the Dominican Republic. Paniagua spent parts of six seasons as a member of the Boston Red Sox and New York Mets minor league systems that included Eastern League experience with Portland (2007) and Binghamton (2008-09). He also spent six seasons (2011-16) with the independent York Revolution and is the longest-tenured position player in franchise history.

In his eighth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens returns to Altoona for a third season in 2019. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. He spent two years in Bradenton from 2015-16, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last six seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger returns to the Curve for his third season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
