THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve lost the first game of their series in Bowie, 1-0, despite six scoreless innings from **Cody Bolton**. The right-hander only needed 76 pitches and retired all but two batters faced. Baysox starter Dean Kremer worked around six of Altoona's seven hits over seven scoreless innings of his own and struck out eight Curve hitters. Carlos Perez hit an RBI double for the only run of the game against Altoona reliever **Joel Cesar** during the seventh inning. It was the first 1-0 final score at Prince George's Stadium since the Baysox beat the Curve on June 23, 2013.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look to bounce back in the second game of their series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It is just the fourth contest between the two clubs on Altoona's 94th game. The Baysox won 2 of 3 on May 6-8 by outscoring the Curve 24-10. Since June 1, Altoona and Bowie have been the hottest teams in the league with the Baysox going a league-best 32-10 and the Curve 27-15. The two second half contenders will play 10 times between now and the end of August with the Curve hosting Bowie on August 16-18 followed by a second visit to Prince George's Stadium on August 22-25.

THE CURVE: The Curve won 7 of 8 before the All-Star Break before they have lost 5 of the last 8 since play resumed on July 11. Each of Altoona's last 12 games have been decided by three runs or less. The Curve are on to the second game of eight straight against Bowie and Erie, the two teams ahead of them in the Western Division standings. The Curve have the best intra-division record (38-25) among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE BAYSOX: Bowie entered play at PNG Field on May 6 with a 7-23 record, the worst record in professional baseball. Bowie took 2 of 3 from the Curve in that series and have been one of the best teams in the game with a 44-21 record since the start of that series. They have been the best pitching team in the league since May 6, owning a 2.88 ERA and have pitched to a 12-3 record in July with a league-best 2.35 ERA this month. Overall, Bowie's pitching rotation is the second-best on the circuit with a 3.52 ERA and ranked fourth overall at a 3.33 ERA despite the most homers allowed (90) in the E.L. From an offensive standpoint, Bowie's hitters lead the league with 4.3 runs per game and a .272 average with runners in scoring position while ranking fourth with a .242 team batting average and fourth with 73 home runs. The Baysox most recently took 2 of 3 over Harrisburg to start their current seven-game homestand.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander **Domingo Robles** makes his 10 Double-A start and is the first Pirates minor league pitcher to reach 20 starts. His last outing was on July 14 in Erie and he allowed four runs over six frames of a no-decision. Robles was the Opening Day starter for A-Adv. Bradenton this season and went 5-5 with a 2.61 ERA in 10 Florida State League starts. Robles, a 21-year-old native of the Dominican Republic, was signed by Pittsburgh as an international free agent on July 2, 2014...*For more on Robles, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander **Zac Lowther** makes his 18th start of the year and second against the Curve. Lowther, a 2019 Eastern League All-Star, struck out eight over 6.2 one-run innings for his 10th victory in his first start after the All-Star Break on July 14 in Akron. He pitched a scoreless fourth inning for the Western Division All-Stars in the E.L. All-Star Game in Richmond that resulted in a 5-0 win over the Eastern Division. The Curve dealt Lowther a losing decision on May 7 after pushing three runs across during his six innings. A native of Northeast Ohio, the lefty leads the E.L. in wins (10) and batting average against (.191) while he ranks third in ERA (2.54), seventh in strikeouts (88), 10th in WHIP (1.13) and walked the sixth-most (43). Lowther was the 74th overall selection by the Orioles in the second Competitive Balance round of the 2017 draft out of Xavier and is the No. 8 prospect in Baltimore's system.

WILD, WILD WEST: The top four teams in the Western Division are all separated by a one game in the full-season standings as Erie leads the way by a half game over the Curve. However, the Curve and SeaWolves are chasing the Baysox in the second half due to the new split-season format as the three teams chase down the last remaining playoff spot in the West. Harrisburg rode a 21-4 record in April to a 42-28 finish to punch their ticket to the postseason as first half division champs.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Bowie's Michael Baumann pitched a nine-inning no-hitter on Tuesday night, the seventh hitless game in the Eastern League in 2019 and the most since a record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. The league-wide batting average stands at .238 with teams scoring 3.99 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The Curve are above the league average by scoring 4.0 runs per game and rank third in hitting at .243. The lowest batting average in team history was .252 during the 2013 season. Strikeouts are also on the rise with E.L. pitchers averaging 8.8 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. Curve pitchers have struck out the fewest hitters (658) among full-season clubs in the Minors while Altoona hitters have struck out 112 times over the last nine games (12.4 per game).

BRAKE MEN: The Curve pitching staff has been dialed in over an extended period and owns the second-best ERA in the league since June 3 (39 games) at 3.02 (117 ER/349.0 IP) and third-best since May 16 (55 games) at 3.17 (168 ER/477.2 IP). After a 6.82 ERA over 12 games from May 3-15, the club's ERA ballooned to a league-high 4.22 but has been trimmed down to 3.59 to rank sixth due to the prolonged run of success.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: **Jared Oliva** is the top hitter in the Eastern League since June 14, leading the league with a .413 (43/104) batting average, .635 slugging percentage, .492 on-base percentage, 1.127 OPS, 43 hits and 18 steals over his last 29 games. He also has the best slashline (.414/.495/.632) in the E.L. since the second half started on June 19. Oliva has raised his average from a season-low .193 over his first 39 games to .281, 10th-best in the E.L. and third in Pittsburgh's system, by getting on base in 36 of his last 39 games by batting .369 (52/141) with 17 multi-hit games since June 3. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system.

TOLMAN AT THE TOP: Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has reached base in 22 of 24 games while hitting .284 (25/88). Since the start of the second half, Tolman leads the league with 21 runs scored, ranks fourth with a .411 on-base percentage and third with 16 walks. He has reached base in 34 of 38 games, including a team season-high 17 in a row from June 24-July 15, and is batting .287 (41/143) with 25 runs, eight steals and nine extra-base hits since June 3.

BRIGHT GUY: **Bligh Madris** has 12 multi-hit games in his last 30 contests since June 12, batting .304 (34/112) with eight doubles and three home runs. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: **Robbie Glendinning** leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a .319 batting average (min. 300 plate appearances) while his career-high 11 homers (7th), 51 RBIs (4th), 23 doubles (3rd) and 92 hits (2nd) between two levels also rank among the organization's best. The Western Australia native was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve. Since his permanent promotion on June 13, his 21 RBIs in 29 games are the fourth-best total in the Eastern League.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).

Ryan returns for his third season in Altoona after guiding the Curve to back-to-back Western Division championships. In his first season, the Curve captured the 2017 Eastern League title. He also managed the Western Division All-Stars in the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Classic. Ryan started his coaching career as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.

Hanrahan joins the Curve in 2019 for his third season as a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh minor league system. He started his coaching career with the Bristol Pirates in 2017 and most recently oversaw pitchers for the West Virginia Power last year. Hanrahan was a two-time National League All-Star with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 and 2012 while he served as the team's closer. He was the first Buccs closer to notch 40 saves in a single season and recorded 82 saves, fifth all-time, during four seasons in Pittsburgh. A second-round pick by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2000, he played 14 totals seasons and seven years as a right-handed reliever in the majors.

Nunnally comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 12th season as a coach in professional baseball. During the 2010-11 seasons, he was the hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians under manager Manny Acta. Nunnally spent the last two seasons as the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. He has served as a hitting coach in the Indians, Toronto Blue Jays and Boston Red Sox developmental systems with Eastern League stops in New Hampshire (2012, 14) and Portland (2016). As a player, Nunnally was drafted by Cleveland in the third round in 1992 and played 15 seasons. He also played six major league seasons.

Paniagua joins the Curve for his third season as a coach in the Pirates organization. He started his coaching career in 2017 with the Bristol Pirates and was the hitting coach for the Dominican Summer League affiliate last year. He played for 13 years as an international signee out of the Dominican Republic. Paniagua spent parts of six seasons as a member of the Boston Red Sox and New York Mets minor league systems that included Eastern League experience with Portland (2007) and Binghamton (2008-09). He also spent six seasons (2011-16) with the independent York Revolution and is the longest-tenured position player in franchise history.

In his eighth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens returns to Altoona for a third season in 2019. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. He spent two years in Bradenton from 2015-16, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last six seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger returns to the Curve for his third season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
