THE LAST TIME OUT: Before an off day on Monday, the Curve were defeated, 7-3, by Reading in the rubber game of their three-game series. After Altoona took an early lead, Mickey Moniak hit a towering homer to right to spark a three-run fifth for Reading. The Curve answered in the sixth to even the score, 3-3. The game remained tied until the ninth inning when the R-Phils sent nine men to the plate and scored four runs, including the go-ahead score on a double by Josh Stephen.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve begin a three-game series versus the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is the first series on City Island between the two since April 22-24 and the two ballclubs have not met since the First and Second Half split on June 17-19. Harrisburg swept the Curve at PNG Field on April 15-17 and took the first two of a three-game set during Altoona's last visit to Pennsylvania's capital. Altoona won each of the last two series at PNG Field, 3 of 4 on May 16-19 and 2 of 3 on June 17-19. The Curve close the 2019 season over Labor Day weekend at FNB Field on August 30-September 2. After Monday's day off, the Curve start the homestretch of the season with the first of the final 21 games in 21 days.

THE CURVE: The Curve went 4-3 on their last homestand, including their first series win since the All-Star Break by taking 3 of 4 over Richmond, after going 1-6 on the previous road trip. After the All-Star Break, the Curve are 11-22 and have been outscored 146-114 and are hitting .227 (2376/1043), the second-lowest average in the league over that stretch. Altoona went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (.49-39). The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE SENATORS: The First Half Western Division Champions are playoff bound for the first time since 2013. Harrisburg rattled off 21 wins in April before beating the Curve by five games through the end of First Half. From May 1 until the All-Star Break, the Senators went 26-37 but have rebounded to a 16-14 since the break, including a 15-12 mark in July. Harrisburg's 3.18 ERA since the break is the second-best in the E.L. and ranks tied for third overall at 3.41, fourth in starter ERA at 3.62 and fifth in bullpen ERA at 3.07. Offensively, Harrisburg is fifth in the league scoring 3.99 runs per game, ninth with a .238 batting average, second with a .260 average with men in scoring position with their 78 homers ranking ninth.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher **Sean Brady** will make his 18th start for the Curve and 23rd overall in 2019. In his last start, he allowed one unearned run over six innings of a 1-0 defeat on August 7 vs. Richmond, which also resulted in his team-leading 12th quality start. Brady has shouldered a losing decision in each of his last three starts despite a 3.32 ERA (7 ER/19 IP) and has been handed the loss in his last four decisions spanning six starts since the All-Star Break. He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school... **For more on Brady, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Jackson Tetreault, a 23-year-old right-hander, takes the hill for his 18th start with Harrisburg and 22nd overall in the Nationals system. He is coming off a winning decision in his last start in Binghamton after five one-run innings. Tetreault faced the Curve on May 17 at PNG Field and picked up the win despite five runs allowed over five innings, a game Harrisburg won 7-5. He opened the year with A-Adv. Potomac and held a 1.23 ERA over four starts in the Carolina League. Tetreault is in his third pro season after he was a seventh round pick by Washington out of the State Junior College of Florida.

BRAKE MEN: Altoona's bullpen has been a lockdown unit since mid-June, owning a 2.98 ERA (62 ER/187 IP) over 55 games since June 12. **Blake Cederlind** has a 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) with 24 strikeouts in his last 18 games since June 14. **Matt Eckelman** is the ninth player in club history to record 20 saves in a single season while his 32 career saves with Altoona are second-most in franchise history. Eckelman has allowed just five earned runs, seven total, with 29 strikeouts in 25 games since the start of June for a 1.67 ERA (5 ER/27 IP). Over 12 outings since June 26, **Joel Cesar** has thrown nine scoreless games with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP). **Yeudy Garcia** has anchored a 2.61 ERA (9 ER/31 IP) in 17 games since May 30. During his last 22 games since May 19, **Angel German** has yanked his ERA down from 7.07 to 4.15 with 17 scoreless outings, allowing just 17 hits, struck out 32 and has a 2.67 ERA (9 ER/30.1 IP). In parts of two seasons with the Curve, **Jesus Liranzo** has allowed just one earned run over 32.2 innings.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.97 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965.

GLOVE TRAIN: The Curve defense has been one of the best units in the Minors all season but has committed 25 errors in their last 25 games since July 19 and 8 misplays over the last five contests. The club's .982 fielding percentage, 72 errors and 110 double plays all rank fourth in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

CRUZ CONTROL: **Oneil Cruz** flourished over his first seven games at PNG Field, going 8-for-24 (.333) with five RBIs with three multi-hit games. The 6-foot-6 shortstop connected on a go-ahead, two-run single on last Monday, the game-tying RBI knock leading up to a Curve win in extra innings on Wednesday and drove home the first run of a 2-0 shutout win on Thursday. Cruz was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors for July. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

J.O. ON A ROLL: **Jared Oliva** has hit safely in 25 of his last 30 games since July 13, batting .351 (40/114). Before back-to-back multi-hit games on Saturday and Sunday, Oliva went 0-for-7 over his previous two games, which was the first time since June 19 & 21 that he did not record a hit in consecutive games. Going back to June 3, Oliva has raised his batting average from a season-low .188 to .287, second in the E.L., by reaching base in 55 of 63 games at a .349 (81/232) pace, 39 points higher than second-best, and has a .414 on-base percentage over that period, also the highest rate in the league. He currently ranks seventh in the E.L. in OPS (.785), seventh in on-base percentage (.362), seventh in hits (108), sixth in triples (5) and sixth in runs (60). In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and leads the Pirates system with 32 steals and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season.

POPE'S POKES: **Brett Pope** has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 51 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .250 by batting .301 (40/133) with eight doubles, one triple and 15 walks for a .361 on-base percentage. Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June. During his last 17 games since July 22, he is hitting .357 (15/42) and is 7-for-17 (.412) with three doubles in nines games to start August.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features four of *Baseball America's* Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder **Oneil Cruz** (No. 3), right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 5), right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 24) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Ponce** (No. 30). After the latest MiLB.com Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), **Jared Oliva** (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever Cederlind (No. 28). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by *Baseball America* as their No. 79 overall prospect while MiLB.com ranks him at No. 62.

MILESTONE TRACKER: The Altoona franchise is 7 wins from reaching 1,500 regular season victories over the ballclub's 21-year history. Manager **Michael Ryan** is 9 wins from 500 for his managerial career and needs three more victories to reach 214 as the Curve skipper, which would be the most by a manager in team history. He is 211-186 overall for the Curve. **Matt Eckelman** is seven saves from passing **Montana DuRapau** for the franchise's all-time saves record.

ALUMINUM REPORT: **Mitch Keller** (2017-18) earned his first MLB win in his return to the Pirates rotation on Monday during the Bucs' 10-2 win in Anaheim. **Josh Bell** (2014-15) swatted his 30th homer, the first Pirate to reach the 30-homer plateau since Pedro Alvarez (2009) hit 36 in 2013, and is tied for the MLB lead in RBIs with 95. Rookie **Bryan Reynolds** is fourth in baseball with a .333 batting average. **Starling Marte** (2011) is one stolen base from his second straight 20/20 season.
